**Provenienz**

Unknown collection, unidentifiable collector's stamp trimmed at the top edge right (not in Lugt); Karl & Faber, Munich, auction 329, 15 November 2024, lot 283.

A very fine lifetime impression of the fifth state, with strengthened contours of the man's lower left leg, yet before the doubled curved stroke on his upper right arm. Indicated by Nowell-Usticke with 'R+': 'A scarce, delicate little print'. Trimmed to the platemarks on three sides, cut 1 mm within on top. – A diagonal, hardly noticeable crease. Paper minimally thinned out in places. Otherwise in good condition.
